



# SUMMER MADNESS 2010

Reserve Bob Morris & Jana Morris**





There was a flag ceremony highlighted by the introduction of a 9-11 flag that was designed by our very own Kenneth Basham. Mr. Ed Avery gave a very emotional and appropriate prayer as he prayed for those currently serving as well as for our fellow shooters, Whitney Alderson and Rochel Ochoa who are recovering from severe burns sustained in a trailer explosion. A moment of silence was then observed after which 9 balloons (3 red, 3 white, and 3 blue) were released into the sky's above the arena.

The Sunday event started at 8am right after we all had the opportunity to take in Cowboy Church presented by our barrel racing friends. Even though this was a "No Frills" shoot it certainly didn't slow down the competitors or the competition. The Barrel Racers were treated to a show as the top spots in each class were battled out in front of them. The overall position was swapped several times with M2 Kenneth Basham leading after stage 1 and things being returned a little back to normal with SM5 Tony Romano taking over the top spot after stage 2. However, the lower level shooters weren't to be out done on this day as after stage 3 M3 Brian Morse was able to take over the lead with M3 Gary Bennett in hot pursuit. With 1 run remaining, Gary Bennett went out and put down a smoking run of 11.732 on course number 22 to temporarily take over the top spot. Not to be out done, Brian Morse then followed Gary with a 12.135 second run that was enough to edge out Gary for the overall spot and take home Overall honors for this day. Jana Morris showed why she is one of the ACMSA's best shooters by edging out L2 Hayley Morse (one ACMSA's up and coming young guns) by 1.191 seconds to claim the Overall Ladies title. Also we want to give a special welcome to first time shooter Ronda Blauvelt who put together a couple clean runs and reminded us all what this sport is all about as she always came back with a huge smile and fist pumps on the clean runs.
